Does a vasectomy interfere with sex drive?

No, a vasectomy won't change your sex drive, hormone level or your ability to get an erection.

Are there any risks?

There are risks associated with medical procedures. For many men, the benefits of vasectomy outweighs the risks. Vasectomy is generally low risks, in rare cases you may experience bleeding, infection, sperm granuloma and prolonged pain.

Does it hurt?

Our doctors are very experienced in what they do. You may feel some discomfort with the local anaesthetic injection but once your skin is fully anaesthetised it should be relatively pain free.

How long does it take?

Our procedure takes 10-15 minutes. Please allow yourself 1 hour for your appointment time

How long is the recovery?

Most men recover within 1-2 weeks. Some people do require longer recovery time.

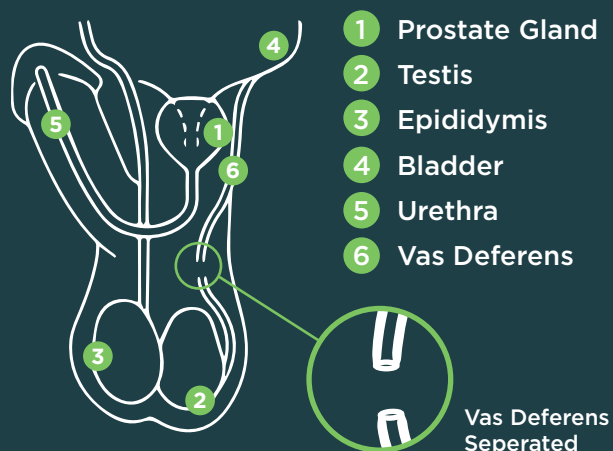
Are you looking for safe birth control options?

A vasectomy offers more than 99% success rate in contraception. Here at The Cooper Clinic, our doctors have performed thousands of non-scalpel vasectomies (NSV) to New Zealand men. Just a quick snip and seal of the tube (vas deferens) that carry the sperm to the outside world.

The NSV technique uses an advanced method to anaesthise the scrotum and vas deferens, which makes the vasectomy procedure essentially minimises the pain. The use of modern electrosurgical device has benefits in having less discomfort, fewer complications and easier recovery.

At our clinic, our vasectomies have one fixed price inclusive of pre-operative care and follow up care done in one single visit across New Zealand. We accept a range of insurance providers. We also have flexible payment options.
